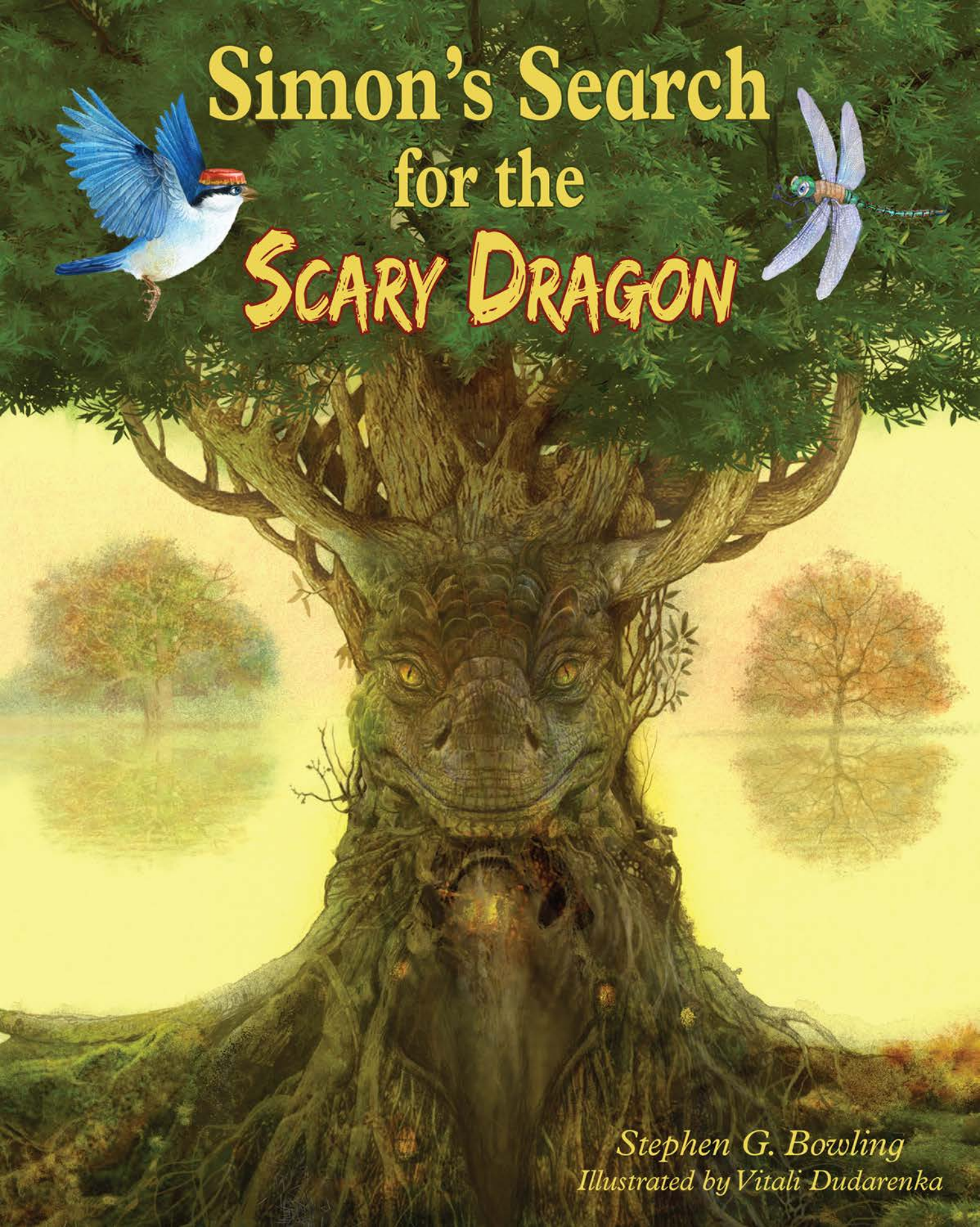

maybe she would know.

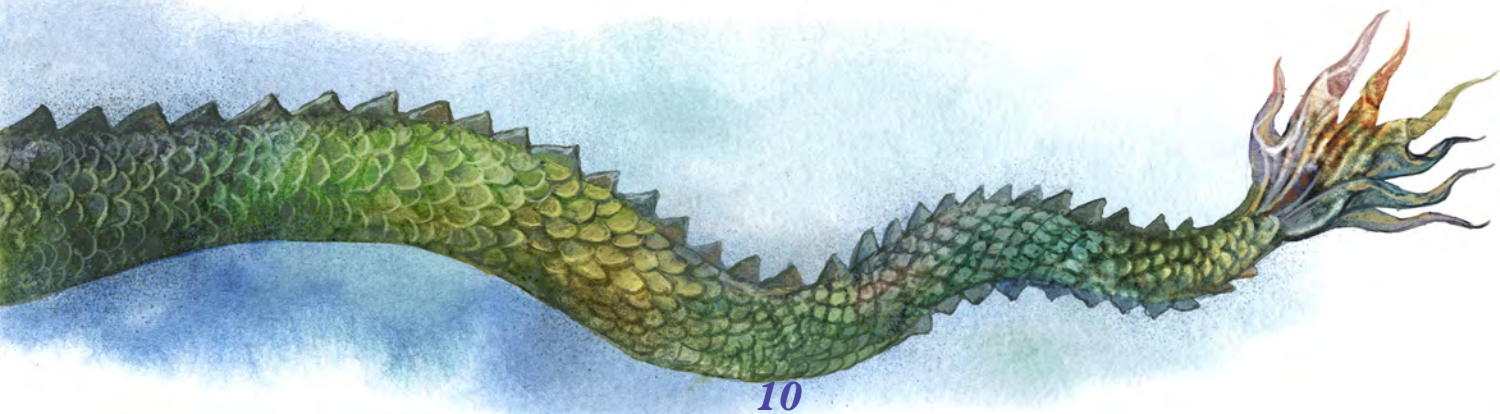
“Have you seen a scary dragon?
