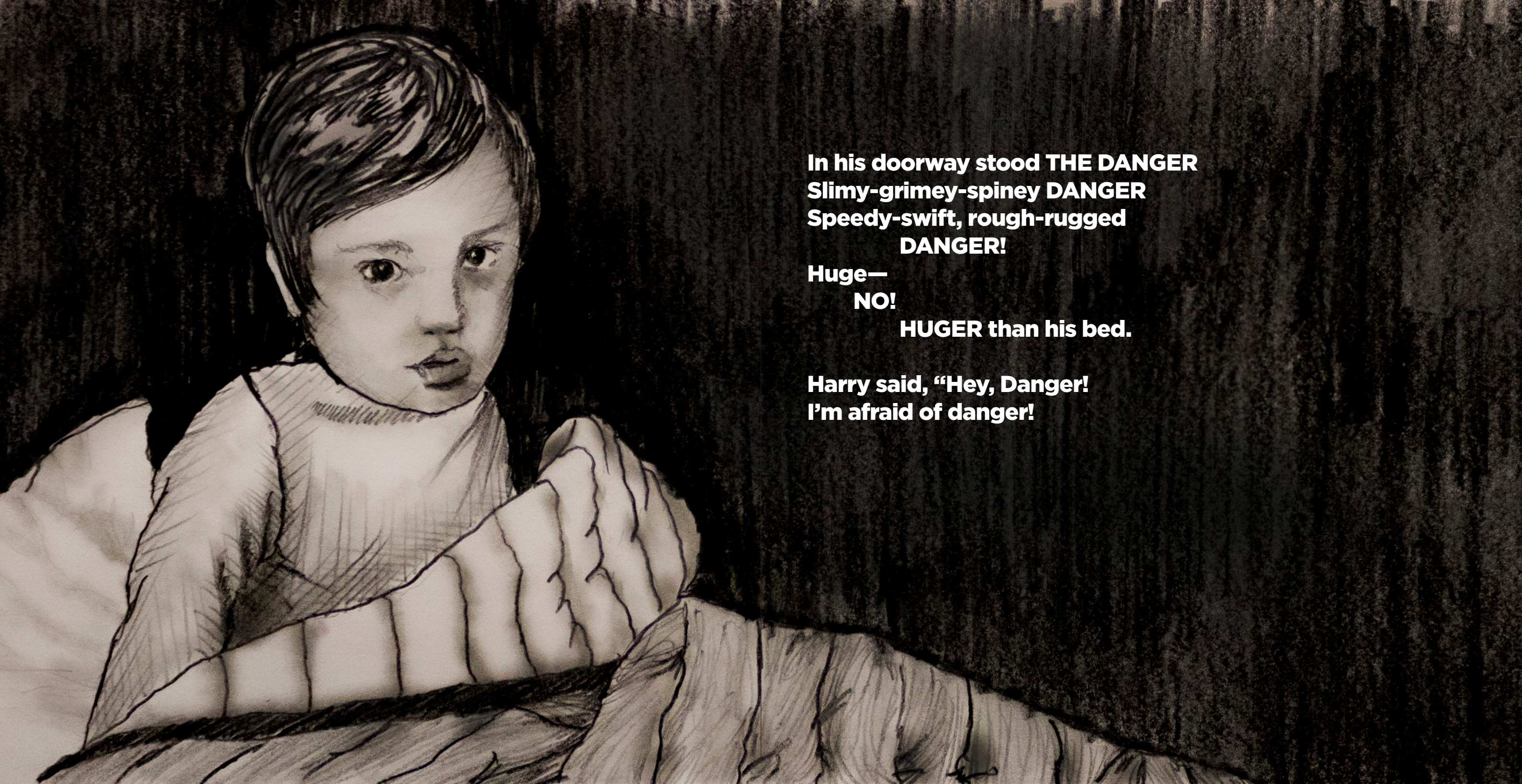




Harry woke at night.
