


Jamie looked under the

nowhere to be found.



nervous.



Jamie asked the tall guards standing there, but they hadn't seen Teddy.







Jamie then visited the

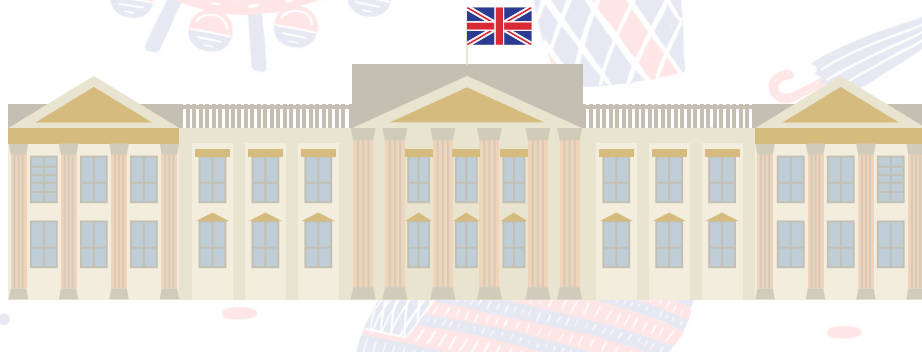
Jamie spoke to the

Garden.




But then, in a small corner of the market, Jamie spotted a little stall with toys and there was Teddy!






Teddy was sitting there

tucked under one arm.**



with Teddy.




Teddy seemed to listen,
